Continuing Ed Opens César E. Chávez Campus to Barrio Logan Community

San Diego Continuing Education will hold a grand opening celebration of its newest educational facility and campus car park on Wednesday. The project consists of a 67,924-square-foot, threestory César E. Chávez Campus building with an underground, 149-car parking area; plus a detached campus car park with 320 additional spaces and murals featuring the life and work of César E. Chávez that is located two blocks east of the campus.

The \$58 million facility and car park is San Diego Continuing Education's final bond-funded new construction.

A program will be held at 10 s.m. at 1901 Main St., San Diego.

The facility houses 22 classrooms for vocational training, English as a Second Language, Citizenship, Adult Basic Education, high school equivalency preparation classes, business and information technology, parent education and Emeritus (age 55+) programs. The new building also includes a multipurpose room, administrative offices, and space for the Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management Program.
